Most projects require a minimum commitment of 2 to 4 hours per week for six months. Shorter projects are designed for student community service hours.</p> <p>Teen volunteers help with special events. This year a Kids Library Camp and Kid Power. Centerville also has two year-round children's reading programs (Oct – May with some breaks following Fremont School District's calendar) that use many teen volunteers. The yearly recruitment is in September but applications are accepted anytime of the year for filling openings when a current volunteer can't continue.
